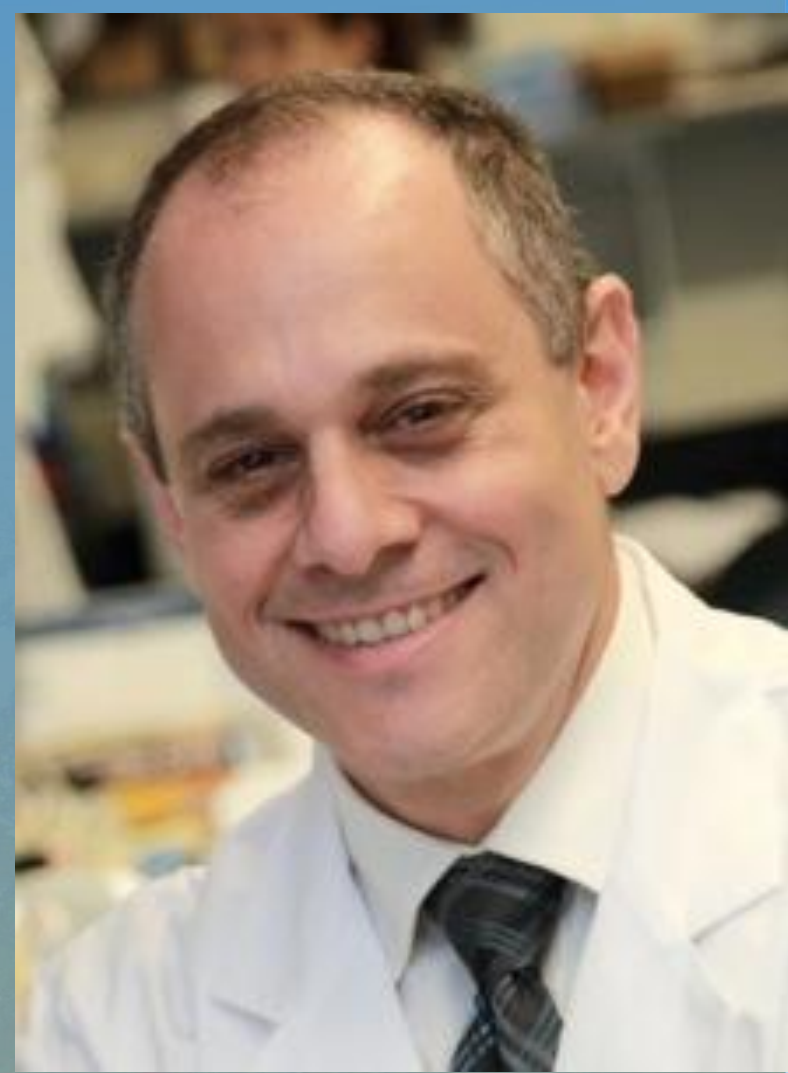

#### Edward A. Fon 教授简介

Edward A. Fon, MD, FRCP(C) is a Clinician-Scientist and attending neurologist at the Montreal Neurological Institute. Dr. Fon is the Director of the McGill Parkinson Program, a National Parkinson Foundation Center of Excellence. He also serves as the Associate Director of the Neuro, Clinical & Translational Research.



Dr. Fon specializes in movement disorders and his research focuses on the molecular events leading to the neuronal degeneration in Parkinson's disease (PD). He is particularly interested in the function and cell biology of PD genes. Dr. Fon's work in this area could provide important clues about disease mechanisms and potentially lead to innovative new therapeutic strategies. His work has been published in prestigious journals including *Science*, *Nature*, *Nature Cell Biology*, *Molecular Cell*, *Neuron*, *EMBO J.*, and *et. al.*
